Internship Opportunity

Internships are an excellent way to get a firsthand look at how a United States Senator serves his constituents. They can be challenging, educational, and fun. Serving an internship in one of Senator John Ensign's state offices enables you to work closely with Senate staff who are responsible for constituent services, and assist D.C. staff on the ground in the state. The program is intended to provide an overview of how a congressional office in the state operates.

Eligibility

Applicants must be U.S. citizens and must have completed their junior year of high school. Nevada residents or students attending college in Nevada will receive priority in the selection process.
